Tax Rate Hearing – The Calhoun Board of Aldermen will hold their annual tax rate hearing on Monday, August 8, 2016 at 7 p.m. to set the 2016 tax rate. This meeting is open to the public. The August council meeting will follow the tax rate hearing.

Primary Election – The Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, August 2nd. Calhoun City Hall is the polling place for Tebo and Springfield Townships. Polls open at 6 a.m. and close at 7 p.m. Handicap parking is available at the rear of the building. City Hall will be closed for business on this day.

Calhoun School Begins – The first day of school for the Calhoun R-VIII School District will be Wednesday, August 17th. Hours this year will be from 7:50 a.m. to 3:19 p.m. Registration will be held on Thursday, August 11th from 8 a.m. to noon and again on Monday, August 15th from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. An open house will be held on Tuesday, August 16th from 5 – 7 p.m. to meet the teachers and bring in your supplies for opening day.

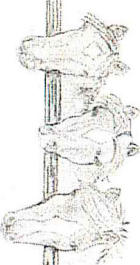

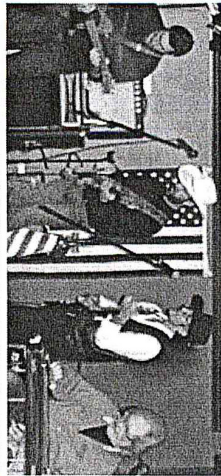
