***SPORTS PHYSICAL REMINDER*** – Parents of students planning on playing fall sports.....here’s some important information for you!!

Golden Valley Medical Clinic is a great supporter of our students and schools, and they once again are supporting area schools by providing sports physicals at no charge to students during the month of July. One change this year is that they will not be hosting a single “sports physical night”. Instead the student-athlete will be encouraged to schedule an appointment with their primary care provider for a well-child exam, which would include the completion of the sports physical form. Physicals will also be conducted through the walk-in clinic. The walk-in clinic hours are Monday-Thursday from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m., Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturday from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. The walk-in clinic is on a first come, first serve basis.

Remember that the participating athlete must have a current physical ***before*** they can even begin practice, so make your appointment today!!
