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NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL CANDIDATE FILINGS – The City of Calhoun will be accepting candidate filings for one South Side Alderman and one North Side Alderman beginning Tuesday, December 12, 2017 and closing Tuesday, January 16, 2018. Each position is for a two-year term. Persons wishing to file for candidacy may do so at the office of the Calhoun City Clerk, 201 E. Main Street, Monday through Friday during regular business hours. The qualifications are as follows:

- At least 21 years of age
- A citizen of the United States
- An inhabitant and a resident of the City of Calhoun for at least one year preceding the election
- Cannot have been found guilty of a felony or misdemeanor under federal laws or to a felony under state law
- Candidate cannot be delinquent in the payment of any state income taxes, personal or real property taxes, or municipal taxes or user fees.

NOTICE TO WATER CUSTOMERS – The City Clerk will no longer be making reminder calls to delinquent water customers prior to shut-off. The shut off date for each month is typically the 26th. However, if the 26th falls on a Friday, weekend or holiday, it will be the next business day. **The shut off date for the month is listed on the back of each water bill. December shut-off date is Wednesday, December 27th. Payment must be received BEFORE this date.**
