## **CITYWIDE CLEANUP MAY 3<sup>RD</sup> – 5<sup>TH</sup>**

The Annual Citywide Cleanup is scheduled for Friday, May 3<sup>rd</sup> through Sunday, May 5<sup>th</sup> from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Dumpsters will be placed at the city barn. We ask that you separate your metal items from trash, as there will be a separate dumpster for metal. No tires, oil, liquid paint, pesticides or household chemicals will be accepted.

Expenses for this event have continued to rise and we ask that a free will donation be made at the time of dumping to help offset the cost of the dumpsters so we can continue this service in the future.

If you need help during the cleanup, please contact City Hall at 660-694-3634 to be placed on a list for assistance.

The Calhoun City Council strongly encourages residents to use this free service to clean their properties. This service is only provided by the City one time per year. Failure to keep your property in order may result in a summons being issued. Be a good neighbor and show some hometown pride by cleaning up your junk!!

## **SERVICE LINE INVENTORY REMINDER**

Calhoun water customers should have received a letter in the mail approximately 30 days ago asking you to identify your water service lines. In order for the City to comply with EPA rule 40 CFR Part 141, we, the City of Calhoun, are required by law to inventory all water service materials from the water meter into the home. If you have not answered the letter, we ask that you do so promptly to assist in our efforts to comply. Refusal to respond could potentially require personnel or a contractor to come to your home to obtain the EPA information and/or dig a hole in your yard outside of the city's easement. This in turn costs the system additional money that may have to be passed onto the water customers, possibly raising water rates. Please understand that a quick response to this customer survey is one of the most helpful things you can do as a citizen to help accomplish this mandate.
