The Calhoun Board of Aldermen will hold a public hearing on Monday, August 10, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. at the Calhoun City Hall, 113 S. Olive St, Calhoun, MO, to receive citizen input and set the 2026 tax rates for the City of Calhoun. The proposed rates are as follows:
